

SCULLEN MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2006-2007

New students and entering 6th grade students are required to have a lock for their PE locker. The LOCK for the PE locker **MUST BE PURCHASED DIRECTLY FROM THE PE Teacher**. (7th/8th grade students can use lock from last year.) The cost is \$4.00. District 204 will be using a new style of shirt required for middle school PE. Returning students may use their existing shirt. **Sixth grade (& new students) will be required to purchase a new shirt either through the PTSA or on line at <http://www.boomer-t.com/>**. The PTSA will be selling the new PE Shirt at SWIM on August 16th for \$10.00.) Students will also need the following: shorts/sweatpants, athletic socks, and gym shoes.

Athletics for 7th/8th grade students

Athletic sports physicals are required for 7th and 8th grade students participating in the interscholastic athletic program. Physicals must be on file with the school nurse prior to a student participating in practice or try-outs. Practice shorts/shirt will be approximately \$20.00 (Optional). There is a fee of \$50.00 per athletic season. (\$100.00 maximum fee for each student per year.) Proof of Insurance/Waiver is also required.

We also ask that students avoid the use of backpacks with wheels as they do not fit in the locker. It may also be necessary for parents to replenish some supplies such as paper, pencils, spirals, and glue periodically throughout the year.

Helpful Suggestions for Buying Supplies

1. **Quinlan and Fabish sends a representative to Scullen once a week. If you call the store anytime to place an order (630.654.4111), they will deliver the items directly to Scullen for delivery to your child in orchestra/band class.** This has been very reliable for our students. It is very convenient for parents, too. Q&F has a copy of our supply list at their store and carries all required items (except the binder/tabs/pencils).
2. **If you are interested in purchasing an instrument, before you buy, please get in touch with Mrs. Lauff, Miss Enstrom, Mr. Duker or Miss Lehman** (or your child's private teacher). We are familiar with many brands and are happy to help you make a worthwhile purchase and investment. Generally, if a price is too good to be true, it probably is! There are a lot of companies manufacturing poor quality instruments that may hinder your child's progress (especially on the Internet, but locally and internationally also). Our district hosts an instrument purchase day in December for orchestra students. Look for information to come home in November regarding this event. However, we are always happy to help throughout the year, too! A high quality instrument is worth the purchase!
