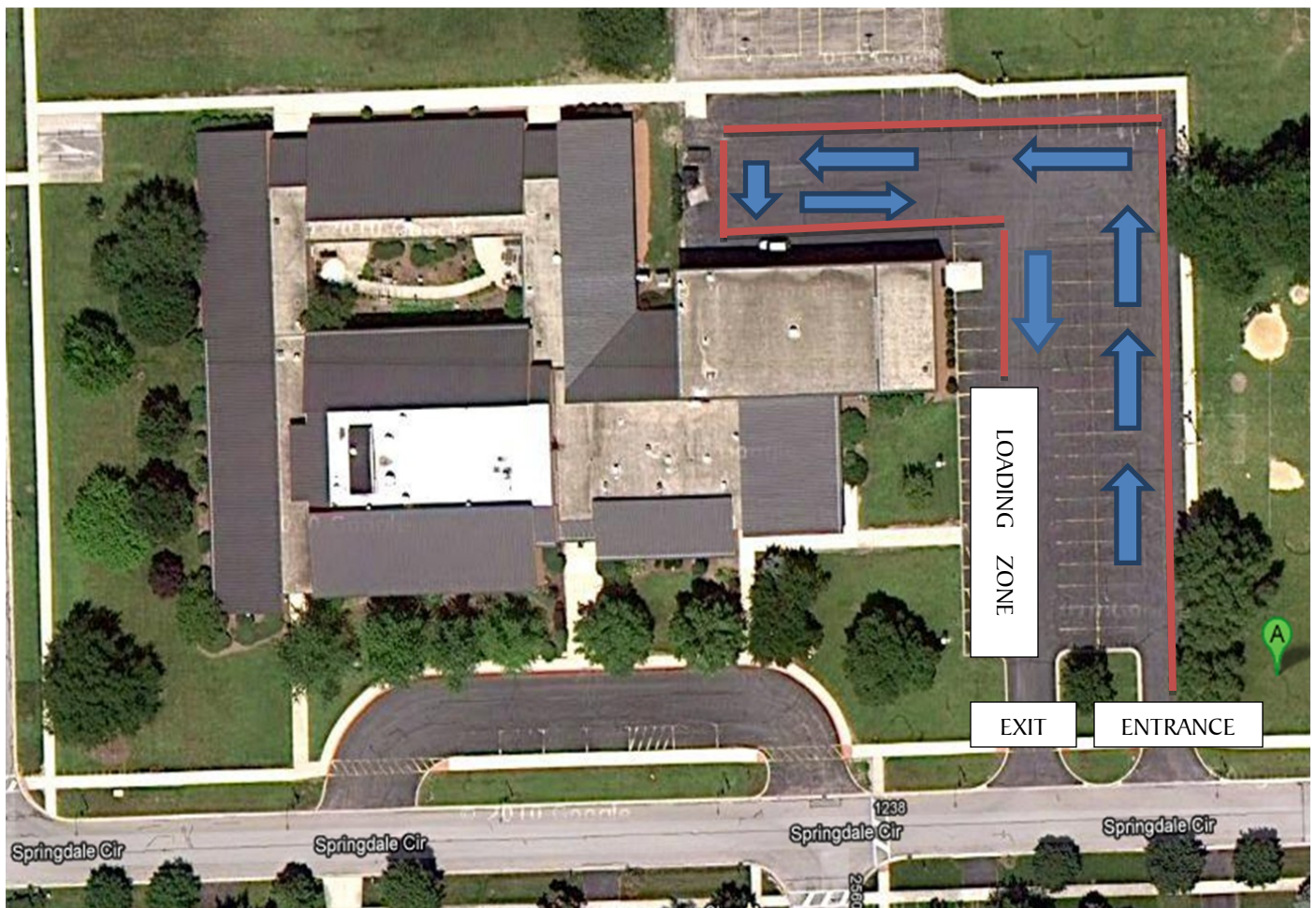

NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN FOR PM PICK-UP...If you pick your child(ren) up from the Faculty Parking Lot in the afternoon, please note the diagram below which outlines a new traffic pattern. The line-up extends to allow for more cars in the pick-up line, eliminating some traffic on Springdale.



There is absolutely **NO PARKING** in the spaces that back up to the playground or field areas between 3:00-4:00. These spaces will be used to make sure all cars can get off of Springdale Circle and in to our parking lot pattern during our pick up times. We expect that this will improve congestion for cars as they exit the lot.
