When is Parent University?

Saturday, February 6, 2010

Where will Parent University be held?

Neuqua Valley High School, 2360 95th Street, Naperville.

The school is located on the south side of 95th street, just west of Book Road. Participants should enter the building through Auditorium door #7.

What time is Parent University?

Program runs from 8 AM – 2:15 PM. Parents can select to attend the full-day program or a half-day program that runs from 8 AM – 11:55 AM

Who is the Keynote Speaker?

Gloria DeGaetano, founder and CEO of The Parent Coaching Institute (PCI)

What is the Keynote going to address?

From her book, *Parenting Well in a Media Age*, Gloria DeGaetano reveals how mass media impacts the emerging self-identity of our kids and how that, in turn, determines their behaviors, attitudes, and values. She will outline a “sane parenting plan” that provides the necessary environment for kids to grow up in this era of social media, texting and sexting, cyber-bullying and violent video games with a strong sense of self, prepared to control screen technologies proactively, effectively, and wisely.

How many workshops are being offered?

There are 13 workshops being offered during each 90-minute session.

What age level do the workshops address?

Three workshops are appropriate for all parents; three specifically target parents of pre-school kids; three target parents of elementary students, and five target parents of middle/high school students. These are clearly marked in the registration materials. Please refer to the registration booklet posted online for more information about the individual workshops.

Am I guaranteed my first choice of workshop?

No. There is a seating capacity for each workshop and registrations are processed on a first come, first served basis. You will be given your first choice of workshop if there is still space in it when we receive your form. If not, you will be placed in your second choice of workshop.

All registrations must indicate a first or second choice of workshop.

Can I attend the full day, but not pay for a lunch?

No, that is not an option.

Do you offer a vegetarian lunch?

Yes. Please check the box on your registration form.

Can my children accompany me to Parent University?

No. This event is designed specifically for adults and seating is limited.
