Foreman Gutmann needs your help to build reading skills at Kendall Elementary. Work on the site commences on October 28, 2007. Report to the site boss each Monday beginning November 5, 2007 if you have completed your job for the week. Shift hours are flexible. The project deadline is November 26, 2007.



The program will begin on Sunday, October 28, and will conclude Monday, November 26.



This is an opportunity for students to practice recreational reading at home. They may read by themselves, with others, or have others read to them.



Attached you will find a Reading Calendar which students may use to track how many minutes they read each day.



Every student is asked to read at least 75 minutes each week; that means reading 5 days a week for 15 minutes a day.



Reading time should be entered on the Reading Calendar and initialed by a parent.



Students are asked to CUT OUT and return the traffic sign reading markers each Monday morning, beginning November 5. These markers will indicate that the student reached his or her reading goal for that week.



We will be filling dump trucks at the construction site on the wall in the LMC. Reading Calendars should be returned to school at the end of the reading program on Monday, November 26, 2007.



Reading minutes for classroom reading assignments may also be used for this program's reading goal.
