

## SCULLEN MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2009-2010

New students and entering 6th grade students are required to have a lock for their PE locker. The LOCK for the PE locker **MUST BE PURCHASED DIRECTLY FROM THE PE Teacher**. (7th/8th grade students can use lock from last year.) The cost is \$4.10. District 204 requires middle school students to wear an approved shirt for PE. Students are required to wear a crew-neck plain light grey T-shirt. The shirt can be either short or long sleeved, but must be free of any insignia or screen printing. T-shirts can be purchased at most department stores including area stores such as Kohl's, Target, and Sports Authority. Returning students may use existing red shirt or choose to wear a grey T-shirt. Students will also need the following: shorts/sweatpants, athletic socks, and gym shoes. All items should bear student's name in permanent marker.

**Athletics for 7th/8th grade students:** Athletic sports physicals are required for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students participating in the interscholastic athletic program. Physicals must be on file with the school nurse prior to a student participating in practice or try-outs. Practice shorts/shirt will be approximately \$20.00 (Optional). There is a fee of \$50.00 per athletic season. (\$100.00 maximum fee for each student per year.) Proof of Insurance/Waiver is also required.

We also ask that students **avoid the use of backpacks with wheels** as they do not fit in the locker.

**7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade Students enrolled in a foreign language** class will need to purchase a workbook for an anticipated cost of \$14.10. The teacher will send home information the first day of school.

All students must have:

- Instrument supplies such as rosin, "Kun" brand shoulder rest for violin/viola students, rock stop for cello/bass students
- Tourte Mute (\$2-5)
- Music stand for home practice
- One 1" three-ring binder (black is preferred)
- One package of tabbed dividers (5 total)
- Pencils
- "Accent" combination metronome/tuner (or other comparable brand)

### **Orchestra Books - 6th Grade**

- Orchestra Expressions Book 1 (yellow book)
- Essential Musicianship for Strings - Fundamental ensemble concepts (red book)

### **Orchestra Books - 7th Grade**

- Orchestra Expressions Book 2 (red book)

### **Orchestra Books - 8th Grade**

## **Helpful Suggestions for Buying Supplies**

1. **Quinlan and Fabish sends a representative to Scullen once a week. If you call the store anytime to place an order (630.654.4111), they will deliver the items directly to Scullen for delivery to your child in orchestra/band class.** This has been very reliable for our students. It is very convenient for parents, too. Q&F has a copy of our supply list at their store and carries all required items (except the binder/tabs/pencils).
2. **If you are interested in purchasing an instrument, before you buy, please get in touch with Mrs. Lauff, Ms. Landa, Mr. Duker or Miss Lehman** (or your child's private teacher). We are familiar with many brands and are happy to help you make a worthwhile purchase and investment. Generally, if a price is too good to be true, it probably is! There are a lot of companies manufacturing poor quality instruments that may hinder your child's progress (especially on the Internet, but locally and internationally also). Our district hosts an instrument purchase day in December for orchestra students. Look for information to come home in November regarding this event. However, we are always happy to help throughout the year, too! A high quality instrument is worth the investment!
