New Student Application 2024-2025 Monthly Tuition Program

Prairie Children Preschool will begin the <u>open application process</u> for new students applying for the tuition program on **January 10**, **2024**.

If you have concerns about your child's development, please call the office before completing a New Student Application.

Applications may be mailed via regular mail or dropped off in the designated bin outside Door#1, **postmarked/dropped off on or after January 10, 2024**. Availability for the tuition program is limited and tuition openings will be filled according to the date received.

<u>Instructions for submitting a New Student Application for the tuition program:</u>

- Complete a New Student Application for each child applying for the tuition program.
- Include a <u>non-refundable</u> application fee of \$30.00 for each child, <u>cash or check only</u>.
 <u>Payment of the application fee does not guarantee enrollment.</u>
- Do not complete an online registration until after you receive a confirmation of enrollment from our office.
- Mail/drop off the application form beginning **January 10, 2024,** to:

Applications <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted if postmarked/dropped off before January 10, 2024.

Applications postmarked/dropped off prior to January 10, 2024 will be returned.

Applications received without payment will be returned.

In April 2024, you will receive via email either a confirmation of enrollment with further registration instructions or notice that your child has been placed on our waiting list.

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ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Students must be three or four years old by September 1st of the current school year. No exceptions.

Families must be current residents of Indian Prairie School District 204 at the time an application is submitted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Students attend EITHER a morning session OR an afternoon session. Students cannot attend both morning and afternoon sessions.

Morning: 7:50 to 10:20 AM Afternoon: 12:10 to 2:40 PM

Days are Monday through Thursday. There is no school for tuition students on Friday.

The Preschool follows the Indian Prairie School District 204 School Calendar.

Tuition students must provide their own transportation. Bus service is not available for tuition students.

Before and after school care is not available.

A <u>non-refundable</u> \$30.00 application fee, cash or check only, must be submitted with the application. **Checks should be made payable to Prairie Children Preschool.**

Monthly Tuition: The monthly cost of the tuition program is as follows:

- 4 Day Tuition Program \$245/month September through May (Rates are subject to change)
- A 15% discount off the monthly fee is applied to each additional sibling attending simultaneously.

In April 2024, you will receive either a confirmation of enrollment with further registration instructions or be placed on our waiting list. If placed, a tuition deposit payment and online registration are due by **May 15, 2024** in order to secure your child's placement. This tuition deposit payment is non-refundable and will be applied to the last month of tuition May 2025 only. The remaining eight installments are due on the first school day of each month, September through April. If the student withdraws for any reason after registration is completed, the tuition deposit payment will be forfeited.

Refunds cannot be made for any absences for any reason, including, but not limited to, illness, vacation, extended vacation, family visits, emergency weather days or moving out of district. If you choose to leave Prairie Children Preschool before or during the school year, for any reason, no refund will be given for the fees already paid, and the May 2024 deposit payment is forfeited and cannot be used to pay any outstanding tuition due. **In the event of an extended vacation, you will be required to continue your tuition payments if you plan to return to the preschool after the vacation.**
